SANDWICH LEVEL CROSSING, SANDWICH

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow safe vehicular access during construction works at Sandwich Railway Station, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Sandwich Level Crossing, Sandwich.

Overnight Weekend closures are planned for a total of up to 6 nights over 3 weekends, as follows

- 8 & 9 March 2020
- 15 & 16 March 2020
- 28 & 29 March 2020

Closures are from 01:00 hours to 05:00 hours per night

Dover Road / New Street will be closed in the vicinity of Sandwich Level Crossing.

The alternative route is via New Street, Harnet Street, Strand Street (plus High Street, The Chain and Galliard Street in opposite direction), Ash Road, A256 Sandwich Bypass, A258 Deal Road and Dover Road.

An alternative route for any pedestrians will be signposted on site.

Local access to the remainder of Dover Road / New Street continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

There is a chance that the planned dates may change, and updated information can be found on one.network – [Network Rail Permit KL810BME2-86-38-080320], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
