**SANDWICH TOLL BRIDGE,
RAMSGATE ROAD, SANDWICH**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow urgent essential bridge refurbishment works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on and near Sandwich Toll Bridge, Ramsgate Road, Sandwich.

A full closure is planned on or after Monday 17 February 2020 for a duration currently estimated at up to 7 weeks.

Ramsgate Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Sandwich Toll Bridge, to the actual extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative routes for through traffic are
Northbound via High Street, The Chain, Galliard Street, New Street, Dover Road, (A256) Deal Road, A256 Sandwich Bypass and Monks Way
Southbound via Monks Way, A256 Sandwich Bypass, Deal Road, Dover Road, New Street, Cattle Market, Harnet Street and Strand Street

The closure also applies to all traffic including pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians. A shuttle bus service will be operated for pedestrians.

Due to the nature of the works, the road will need to remain closed at all times.

Alternative routes during planned weekend overnight closures of Sandwich Level Crossing are as follows
Northbound via High Street, The Chain, Galliard Street, New Street, Cattle Market, Moat Sole, Woodnesborough Road, St Bart's Road, A258 Dover Road, Deal Road, A256 Sandwich Bypass and Monks Way
Southbound via Monks Way, A256 Sandwich Bypass, A258 Deal Road, Dover Road, St Bart's Road, Woodnesborough Road, Moat Sole, Cattle Market, Harnet Street and Strand Street
