Ash Road, Sandwich
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to the level crossing, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Ash Road, Sandwich.

A closure is planned from 02.00 12th September 2021, with estimated completion by 19.00 12th September 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870BME2-85-60-120921 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Ash Road will be closed at the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while crossing works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Ash Road, Sandwich Bypass, Deal Road, Dover Road, New Street, Cattle Market, Harnet Street, Strand Street and vice versa.
