**BEACON LANE, WOODNESBOROUGH,
SANDWICH**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to install a new foul sewer, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Beacon Lane, Woodnesborough, near Sandwich.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 9 August 2021, with estimated completion by 23 August 2021.

Beacon Lane will be closed east of the junction with Beacon Hill Road, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Beacon Lane, Drainless Road and Foxborough Hill.

Local access to the remainder of Beacon Lane continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
