WOODNESBOROUGH ROAD, SANDWICH

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide new water connections, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Woodnesborough Road, Sandwich.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 2 August 2021, with estimated completion by 4 August 2021.

Woodnesborough Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 129, with no through access between the junctions with St Bart's Road and Poulders Road.

The alternative route for through traffic is via St Bart's Road, Dover Road, A256 Sandwich Road, Statenborough Lane, Foxborough Hill, Fir Tree Hill and Sandwich Road back to Woodnesborough Road.

Local access to the remainder of Woodnesborough Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
